



What is radon?

Radon is an invisible, odourless gas. You can't see radon. You can't smell it or taste it. But it may be a problem in your home.

Radon comes from the natural breakdown of uranium in soil, rock and water. When radon seeps into a closed-in space like a house, it can be harmful. The radon gas can become trapped inside. Any home, no matter the age, could have high levels of Radon.

Did you know...

Manitoba has some of the highest levels of radon in the country!

Radon levels vary from house to house, even in neighbouring homes!

Radon is the #1 cause of lung cancer in non-smokers.

The best time to test is during heating season for 3+ months.

How do I know my radon level?

The only way to know, is to test!
